In order to help you get back in the labour market, various free training services are provided during different periods. To be eligible, you must obtain authorization from your Emploi-Québec agent prior to starting the training program and be in one of the following situations:

Eligibility conditions:

- Be receiving employment insurance or have received benefits during the last four years or five years for maternity or paternity benefits, or
- Be receiving employment assistance or be a social solidarity recipient, or
- Not be receiving any government income support.
